ORDINANCE REQUIRED BY THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NJDOT) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT HOVCHILD BOULEVARD AND PREMIUM OUTLETS BOULEVARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Tinton Falls as follows:

SECTION I. That the intersection of Hovchild Boulevard and Premium Outlets Boulevard shall be controlled by a Traffic Control Signal in accordance with the plan bearing the date of November 10, 2008.

SECTION II. That the Traffic Control Signal installed shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Title 39 of the Revised Statutes and the New Jersey Administrative Code; shall conform to the design and shall be maintained in operation, as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT).

SECTION III. That all prior Ordinances or Resolutions or portions thereof of the Borough of Tinton Falls inconsistent herewith be and therefore are repealed.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication as required by law and upon approval of the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation.

SECTION V. That if any clause, section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION VI. When the Ordinance is finally adopted, the Borough Clerk of the Borough of Tinton Falls is to send a certified copy to Douglas R. Bartlett, Manager, Bureau of Traffic Engineering and Investigations, New Jersey Department of Transportation, 1035 Parkway Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0613.

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after it has been adopted and published in accordance with applicable law.
