ORDINANCE NO. 09-1285

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Tinton Falls, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, held on November 10, 2009. This Ordinance will be further considered for adoption, after the public hearing is held thereon, at a meeting of the Borough Council to be held on Tuesday, December 1, 2009, in the Municipal Center, 556 Tinton Avenue, Tinton Falls, NJ beginning at 7:30 o'clock P.M., and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who shall request the same.

ORDINANCE AMENDING § 2-2.15 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF TINTON FALLS

WHEREAS, five (5) minutes is a reasonable amount of time for individual members of the public to address the Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, limiting the time to address the Borough Council to five (5) minutes will provide more members of the public with a greater opportunity to address the Borough Council without having to wait late into the evening to speak; and

WHEREAS, the Council President will maintain discretion in allowing members of the public to exceed the five (5) time limit when appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Tinton Falls in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that § 2-2.15 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Tinton Falls be supplemented and amended as follows:

§ 2-2.15 ADDRESSES TO THE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Upon recognition by the Council President, the person shall proceed to the floor and give their name and address in an audible tone of voice for the record. Statements shall be addressed to the Borough Council as a body and not to any member thereof or Borough employees or professionals unless called upon to address the person by the Council President. A Councilmember shall not direct any question to a speaker addressing the Borough Council except through the Council President. A person speaking shall be limited to five (5) minutes at the discretion of the Council President.
