

## NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE

### ORDINANCE NO. 09-1286

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Tinton Falls, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, on November 10, 2009. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, 556 Tinton Avenue, in the Borough of Tinton Falls, on December 1, 2009 at 7:30 P.M. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$1,095,000 For Acquisition of Various Items of Equipment For And By The Borough Of Tinton Falls In The County Of Monmouth, New Jersey And, Authorizing The Issuance Of \$1,040,250 Bonds Or Notes Of The Borough For Financing Part Of The Appropriation.

Purpose(s): Acquisition of five sport utility vehicles for Police Department and acquisition of various items of equipment for Public Works Department including but not limited to automated side loader and rear loader refuse trucks, four wheel drive truck, front loading automated containers, residential trash containers, asphalt hot box, asphalt planer, maintenance garage exhaust system, and robotic camera and television systems.
