

**NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE  
ORDINANCE NO. 10-1292**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Tinton Falls, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, on March 16, 2010. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, 556 Tinton Avenue, in the Borough of Tinton Falls, on April 6, 2010 at 7:30 o'clock P.M. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$2,162,900 For 2010 Road Improvement Program For And By The Borough Of Tinton Falls In The County Of Monmouth, New Jersey And, Authorizing The Issuance Of \$1,819,250 Bonds Or Notes Of The Borough For Financing Part Of The Appropriation.

Purpose(s): 2010 Road Improvement Program for improvements to various roads including but not limited to Hockhockson Road, Riveredge Road - Phase II, Heritage Drive (NJDOT funding), Mulberry Lane, Laurel Court, Meadow Drive, Stratford Avenue and Devon Court; Miscellaneous Road Improvements to: Riveredge Road, Canterbury Lane, Winchester Drive, Rutgers Drive and Water Street; and improvements to various road (to the extent funds available) including Old Farm Road, Old Mill Road, Marland Lane, Colonial Drive and Squankum Road Sidewalk; and Sidewalk improvements at Hockhockson Road and Liberty Park II, all as shown on and in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk.
