ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$109,756.41 FOR THE CRAWFORD HOUSE ADA ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF TINTON FALLS, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF TINTON FALLS, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$109,756.41 is hereby appropriated, \$29,719.41 of which is from the Capital Fund Reserve - Historic District Improvements and \$80,037.00 of which is from the Community Development Block Grant Program for the Crawford House ADA Accessibility Improvements, including, but not limited to, installation of a handicap parking area and a ramp to the existing covered porch structure as well as construction of an ADA compliant doorway transitions, electric door activators for handicap use, and widening of doorways. Other improvements include installing a handicap accessible kitchen, bathroom and fire horn with strobes, and further including, all work and materials necessary therefore and incidental thereto by the Borough of Tinton Falls, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey.

Section 2. The capital budget of the Borough of Tinton Falls is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by the law.

STATEMENT

The Ordinance published herewith has been finally adopted and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement.
