NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Tinton Falls, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, on August 16, 2011. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, 556 Tinton Avenue, in the Borough of Tinton Falls, on September 20, 2011 at 7:30 o' clock PM. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$1,067,000 For Various Capital Improvements For And By The Borough Of Tinton Falls In The County Of Monmouth, New Jersey And, Authorizing The Issuance Of \$996,550 Bonds Or Notes Of The Borough For Financing Part Of The Appropriation

Purpose(s): Acquisition of salt shed doors and acquisition of various items of equipment and vehicles for Public Works Department including but not limited to dump trucks with plows, wheel loader with attachments and plow, dump truck with plow and spreader, plow extensions with attachments, rear load refuse truck, front loading dumpsters, 3/4 ton utility truck and information and technology equipment, acquisition of in car digital video equipment and pick up truck with plow and accessories for the Police Department; acquisition of computers and software for the Finance Department; and improvements to Fuel Island.
