RE: Illuminated sign for Pinebrook Hose Co.


Mr. Skudera:

As the last Tinton Falls fire company without signage along a major road, we would like to install an illuminated sign along Wayside Road. We would do this to increase visibility of the firehouse, as well as make the community aware of the fact that the company is a part of the community, because many nearby residents are not aware that they are served by Pinebrook. While the sign would be primarily used to announce firehouse events and fire prevention awareness, we also hope that it could be used to advertise Borough events, such as Community Day or other like events.


The location we think would be best for such a sign is Block 96, Lot 12.3, which according to the Tax Assessor's office is owned the Borough of Tinton Falls and is along Wayside Road, near Pinebrook Road. We are seeking the Borough's permission to install a sign of approximately 4'x8' at this location, in accordance with Borough ordinances and County regulations. This sign would be illuminated only from dusk to 2200 hours, varying with the seasons.

We also understand that the Borough has electric service on site, and we would like to use this connection to power the sign, and of course any hookup expenses and would be paid by the Company. We are proposing that the Borough pay power costs in exchange for the sign being used for the Borough's community messages. We would like to meet with you to negotiate the specifics of such an agreement, and to decide on specific details such as how much space on the sign would be available to you, and how often and for how long the sign would be illuminated.
