Community service is good for you!

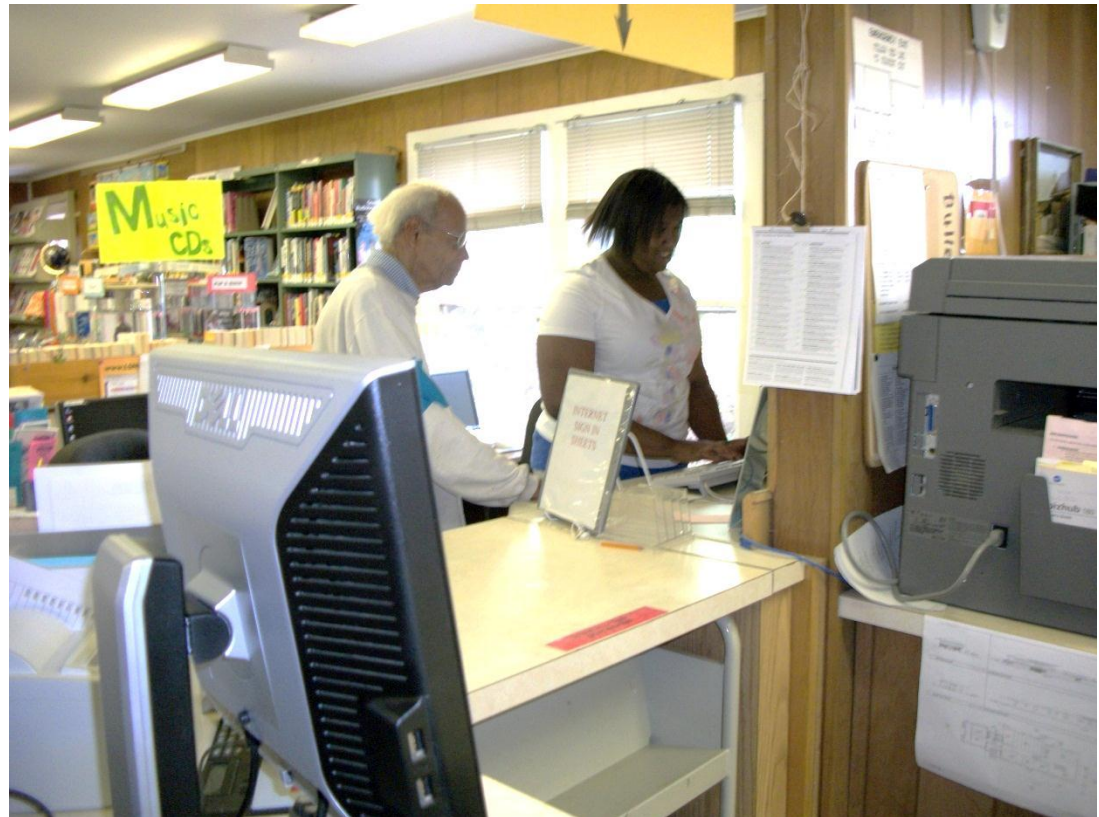


Volunteers help keep the library going
