

# Tinton Falls Open Space Committee Annual Canoe/Kayak Trip

**What:** Please join the Tinton Falls Open Space Committee on a 2 to 3 hour canoe/kayak trip. The tour will start on Pine Brook which flows into Swimming River. The first leg will head toward the bridge on Newman Springs Road and then turn around for the return leg to Pine Brook.



**When:** Saturday, September 27, 2014

**Where:** On a portion of the Swimming River that flows through Tinton Falls. Meet at the small bridge on Riverdale East.

**Time:** Please arrive by 11:30 am.  
Departure time will be close to noon and returning no later than 3 pm.

**Who:** All levels of boaters including beginners are welcome. IF you have your own PFD (life jacket) please bring it. We have a limited number of canoes that are being provided by the Tinton Falls Boy Scouts, however, participants are encouraged to bring their own kayaks and/or canoes.

Parking of autos will be allowed along the roadside west of the little bridge over Pine Brook.

\*\*\*Please be aware that the steep embankment at the Riverdale East Bridge where we will be floating our canoes and kayaks is often very muddy and please dress accordingly.
