The Borough of Tinton Falls Mayor & Council, Administration, Office of Emergency Management, and Police Department are monitoring the developing situation involving presumptive positive cases of Coronavirus in Monmouth County. At the present time there is no reason for the Borough of Tinton Falls to deviate from normal operations. Municipal offices remain open and regularly scheduled meetings will continue to be held.

The Borough receives regular updates from various County, State and Federal agencies and remains in regular contact with Tinton Falls Public Schools and Monmouth County officials.
